



## I. Patterson/Sutton Duo

### *Eclectic Influences: An In-Depth Look at Stephen Goss's Park of Idols for Cello & Guitar*

Praised by *The Strad* magazine for their “wit and imagination,” the Patterson/Sutton Duo are in high demand as they bring the rich cello and guitar repertoire to audiences around the world. In this virtual presentation, the adventurous duo will dissect in detail one of the pieces on their Salon Series program, Stephen Goss's *Park of Idols*.

Kimberly Patterson (cello) and Patrick Sutton (guitar) formed their duo in 2011 as doctoral students at the University of Colorado in Boulder. Their collaboration has led to recitals, residencies and lectures throughout the U.S. and abroad. Juilliard Global Visiting Artists, the Patterson/Sutton duo were featured artists at the 2016 Guitar Foundation of American Convention. They maintain an on-going relationship with The Juilliard School, which sent the duo to Vietnam as guest artists to perform and teach at schools throughout the country as part of the Juilliard/Nord Anglia global initiative. Funded by the U.S. State Department, the duo held a guest artist residency at the Afghanistan National Institute of Music in Kabul in 2014.

In May 2013 the duo released their debut album, *Cold Dark Matter: Music for Cello & Guitar*.” Composer/guitarist Dusan Bogdanović declared, “Everything (on *Cold Dark Matter*) is performed with excellence and sensitivity.” The duo has been featured on Performance Today/American Public Media, Radio New Zealand, and Fine Music Radio South Africa, among many others.
